Subject: **Disbursement of Arrears to the eligible teachers (as defined in the UGC Regulations) of State-Aided Universities in West Bengal.**

Sir/Madam,

The Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, vide their letter no. F.No. 1-9/2009-U.II(i) dated 31.07.2013, has released an amount of Rs. 313,93,08,508/- as the first instalment of the total Central share of Rs. 751,15,38,580/- , being 80% of the arrears, payable to the teachers (as defined in the UGC Regulations) of the State-aided Universities and Govt. /Govt.-aided Colleges of West Bengal under the administrative control of this Department for the period from 1.1.2006 to 31.3.2010.

Out of this amount, the Finance Department, Government of West Bengal has allotted an amount of Rs. 46,93,08,508/- (Rupees Forty-six crore ninety three lakh eight thousand five hundred and eight) only under the head-of-account “ 2002-03-102-NP-009-V-31-01” vide their U.O. No 1289 (Group – N) dated 20.09.2013 as the amount payable to the teachers (as defined in the UGC Regulations) of the State-aided Universities under the administrative control of this Department.

Accordingly, this Department is releasing part of the arrears based on the calculations submitted by the Universities in response to this Department’s order no. 900(17)-Edn(U)/1U-38/11 dated 5.09.2013, **subject to the condition that the University will amend its Statutes, Ordinances, Rules, etc. in line with the Scheme of Revision of Pay and Allowances of the teachers of Universities within 3 (three) months from the date of issue of the sanction order by the MHRD, Government of India, i.e. within 31st October, 2013.**

This disbursement is applicable to all eligible teachers (as defined in the UGC Regulations) in the State-aided Universities who were in service on or after 1/1/2006 and not applicable to teachers, re-employed for any term before 1.1.2006, between 1.1.2006 and 31.3.2010 or after 31.3.2010.
